CRAWFORD CITY COUNCIL/RURAL FIRE BOARD

MEETING MINUTES MAY 13TH, 2015

Members of the City Council of the City of Crawford, Nebraska, met in special session in the Crawford Fire Hall, 220 Elm Street, Crawford, Nebraska on the 13th day of May, 2015, at 7:00 o'clock p.m. The following individuals were present: Mayor David Nixon, Council Member Ed Kuhnel, Council Member Karla Adams and Council Member Roy Norgard. Absent: Attorney Adam Edmund and Council Member Skip Chubb.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting at three locations: City Hall, D & S Market and the US Post Office, as certified and filed in the City Clerk's office at City Hall. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice of the Mayor and City Council of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Mayor Nixon called the meeting to order and declared a quorum present at 7:00 p.m. and announced to the public that a copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted on the wall in the Crawford Fire Hall. It is also available in pamphlet form.

A proposed location for the new Fire Hall would be west of First Street and north of McPherson St. Since the area immediately west of First Street would require approximately \$200,000 in dirt work to raise it up for proper drainage, that area could be used for driveways, access, etc. There are four flags on the knoll that mark where the building would actually be located. West of the building would be available for parking. This would utilize most of the area up to the access road to the City's "balloon" building. The estimated cost has been reduced to \$1.3 million.

The Mayor stated that this location is the most desired area to build on and there is also interest within that area for a motel and/or medical clinic. The flood-plain map indicated that the area is not within the flood-plain.

It was suggested to meet at the property to view the site in the morning, but it was decided to conclude the meeting at the site this evening while it was still daylight. The site was viewed.

The May 13, 2015 special meeting of the City Council and Rural Fire Board adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
