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CITY COUNCIL WORKSHOP MINUTES

JUNE 17, 2015

Members of the City Council of the City of Crawford, Nebraska, met in special session in the City Hall Council Chambers, 135 Elm Street, Crawford, Nebraska on the 17th day of June, 2015, at 6:30 o'clock p.m. The following individuals were present: Mayor David Nixon, Council Member Ed Kuhnel, Council Member Karla Adams, Council Member Skip Chubb and Council Member Roy Norgard. Absent: Attorney Adam Edmund.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting at three locations: City Hall, D & S Market and the US Post Office, as certified and filed in the City Clerk's office at City Hall. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice of the Mayor and City Council of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Council President Skip Chubb called the meeting to order and declared a quorum present at 6:30 p.m. and announced to the public that a copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted on the wall in the Council Chambers. It is also available in pamphlet form.

Representatives of the Northwest Nebraska Shooter's Association expressed concern of the Mud Truck area encroaching into the 300-yard safety zone around the Gun Range that is required by NRA insurance. The insurance covers the members, but not property such as the portable restrooms. The Gun Range will close during the Mud Track events and will post those closings at the range and also email the closing dates to their members. After this season, the Mud Track will likely need to move further south. The Park Board may be asked to designate the areas for the Gun Range and Mud Truck activities. Ed Kuhnel volunteered to contact the owner of the horses that are grazing, apparently without permission, in that area.

Golf Course advertising in the Lincoln-Omaha area was discussed.

The past agreements for a water-main easement in exchange for water were discussed.

The June 17, 2015 special meeting of the City Council adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
