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CITY COUNCIL BUDGET WORKSHOP MINUTES

AUGUST 16, 2018

Members of the City Council of the City of Crawford, Nebraska, met in a workshop session in the City Hall Council Chambers, 135 Elm Street, Crawford, Nebraska on the 16th day of August, 2018, at 5:30 p.m. The following individuals were present: Mayor David Nixon, Council Member Ed Kuhnel, Council Member Roy Norgard, Council Member Connie Shell and Council Member Larry Olson. Absent: Attorney Adam Edmund.

Notice of the workshop was given in advance thereof by posting at three locations: City Hall, D & S Market and the US Post Office, as certified and filed in the City Clerk's office at City Hall. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice of the Mayor and City Council of this workshop. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened workshop was open to the attendance of the public.

Mayor David Nixon called the workshop to order and declared a quorum present at 5:30 p.m. and announced to the public that a copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted on the wall in the Council Chambers. It is also available in pamphlet form.

The budgets were discussed for the Water and Waste Water departments. Mike Kesselring presented a priority list of water and sewer needs. Four water projects are estimated at \$398,219 and one sewer project is estimated at \$86,719. It is hopeful that a bond to pay for the water projects could be structured in such a way that the payments could be made from the Ready-to-Serve receipts.


Other projects on the priority list: \$9,000 for a new pump and pipe at Supplemental Well #2; replacement of the controller valve positioners and butterfly valves estimated from \$12,000 to \$20,000; and a new sewer jet, possibly on a trailer. Tim Kreider will be asked if there are any insurance concerns for sewer jets and confined spaces.

Mike Kesselring will check on any interest in buying three old pumps. There are also a lot of issues to be considered in supplying water to the Wacipi area.


The next workshop is scheduled for August 22, 2018 and will address the General fund and review the Library and Street budgets.
