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## CITY COUNCIL BUDGET WORKSHOP MINUTES

### AUGUST 22, 2018

Members of the City Council of the City of Crawford, Nebraska, met in a workshop session in the City Hall Council Chambers, 135 Elm Street, Crawford, Nebraska on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August, 2018, at 5:30 p.m. The following individuals were present: Mayor David Nixon, Council Member Ed Kuhnel, Council Member Roy Norgard, Council Member Connie Shell and Council Member Larry Olson. Absent: Attorney Adam Edmund.

Notice of the workshop was given in advance thereof by posting at three locations: City Hall, D & S Market and the US Post Office, as certified and filed in the City Clerk's office at City Hall. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice of the Mayor and City Council of this workshop. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened workshop was open to the attendance of the public.

Mayor David Nixon called the workshop to order and declared a quorum present at 5:30 p.m. and announced to the public that a copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted on the wall in the Council Chambers. It is also available in pamphlet form.


The budgets were reviewed and discussed for the Public Library and Street departments. A summary of the survey conducted by the Public Library was presented. To reduce expenses, discussion was held on reducing the open hours of the Library from 29 hours per week to 20 hours per week, and reducing paid wage hours from a total of 55 hours per week to 35 hours per week.

The Street department budget was reviewed. Additions included allocating \$10,000 of Keno funds for curb-and-gutter projects; and increasing the expected revenue from the sale of surplus buildings for allocation to Street Shop improvements.


The General fund was briefly discussed with some reductions in expense items of training, professional fees and repairs-to-building.
